



## Call for Applications: 3-4 positions (Doc/Postdoc) in the ERC Project "Paratexts of the Bible"

The positions at the Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München are for a period of two years, starting from the earliest convenient date. Salary is according to the German scale TV-L, level 13. Applications are welcome both from doctoral and post-doctoral candidates. In the first case the contract will be of 65%, in the second ca. 80% (flexible).

Applicants should be highly qualified in the subjects of philology/ancient Greek, theology/church history, Byzantine studies, or ancient history. Very good knowledge of classical, biblical, or Byzantine Greek is required, and in addition knowledge of at least two relevant modern scholarly languages. The capability for working well on a research team is essential.

For postdoctoral applicants a doctorate in a relevant field and experience in handling Greek manuscripts is required. Previous knowledge in the fields of critical text-editing, bible scholarship, Greek paleography, codicology, or digital humanities is a plus.

For (prospective) doctoral students, successful completion of a master's degree, as well as a doctoral dissertation planned or already begun in a relevant area, is required. Supervision of a doctorate in the fields of Church History, Greek philology, or Byzantine studies is possible, with the option of co-advising as well.

Applications should comprise the following materials:

- CV including list of publications
- Academic writing sample of 20-40 pages (1 or 2 published articles, chapter from doctoral or master's thesis, or something similar)
- Cover letter explaining reasons for interest in the project and description of qualifications for it
- For doctoral students: information on the/a (planned) doctoral project, and statement of desired or existing dissertation supervision
- Contact information for two references who can be reached for further information

The application materials may be submitted in English, French, German, or Italian. Those whose first language is not German should state their ability level in German. Applications by researchers with a handicap will be considered with priority under equal conditions. We encourage women to apply.
